Photography By-Laws

Made by the Executive Committee under Paragraph 9 of the Club Rules on 10 January 2023.

Re-adopted by the Executive Committee of Guernsey Aero Club LBG at a board meeting held on 8 April 2025.

The Executive Committee wishes to publish guidelines on the taking of photographs at the Club in the form of these By-Laws. Generally, the Executive Committee supports photography in and around the Club premises to provide a permanent record of successful social and flying events attended by and enjoyed by Members and their guests.

The Committee do however wish to lay down some guidelines for photographers.

- Photography should not be intrusive upon Members/guests' enjoyment of events;
- Photographs may only be taken with the prior consent of all the subjects in the proposed photograph;
- A request not to be photographed must be respected and no pressure placed upon the declining subject;
- Subjects must be made aware prior to photography that the resulting photographs may be published on the Club website and/or social media;
- Special care needs to be taken when photographing children and minors. This should be avoided and may only be done with the express permission of their parent or guardian;
- Photographers should avoid inadvertently including children or minors as background subjects in photographs wherever possible.
