Car Park By-Laws

Made by the Executive Committee under Paragraph 9 of the Club Rules on 10 January 2023.

Re-adopted by the Executive Committee of Guernsey Aero Club LBG at a board meeting held on 8 April 2025.

Amended by the Executive Committee of Guernsey Aero Club LBG at a board meeting held on 17 September 2025.

Amended by the Executive Committee of Guernsey Aero Club LBG at a board meeting held on 9 December 2025.

These By-Laws shall be read in conjunction with Rule 24 of the Club Rules. All vehicles are parked at the owners' risk and the Club shall not be held responsible for any loss or damage.

Members are to note that the Club Car Park has been designated as 'Les Terres Mises à L'Amende' pursuant to an Order of the Guernsey Royal Court. This designation allows the Club to enforce a set fine (currently £50.00) against those who trespass (i.e. park a vehicle) on the car park without permission.

Parking on Club premises is reserved for Members and their guests when those guests are visiting with a member

Terre à L'Amende is in place for your benefit, so that you can use the car park when you need to. Members must ensure that full details of their vehicle(s) are provided to the Club

Administrator and they must update us with any changes to their vehicle registration number(s) and type of car to keep the members' database current.

All vehicles parked within the car park must be in roadworthy condition, fully driveable and insured with a minimum of third party liability cover. In accordance with Guernsey Law, a valid insurance disc must be clearly displayed whilst parked in the car park.

The car park is checked regularly and any inaccuracies on the database can lead to unnecessary difficulties.

For the efficient use of the car park:

- 1) Please do not park in the area by the Clubhouse marked as a turning point as this area must be kept clear for access to the rubbish bins, oil tank, cesspit and fire hydrant and for delivery and emergency vehicles.
 - 2) Please ensure that the parking spaces closest to the building are used only for short term parking especially short-term visitors and deliveries, i.e. no overnight parking.
 - 3) Overnight and long stay parking is for Full Club Members only, and applies only to a vehicle owned by themselves (or a hire car/loan car which may be in substitution while their car is being repaired with prior notification). In order to use this Members' Only privilege, a parking disc must be purchased at the commencement of the Membership period for a set fee which will be determined by the Committee, and may be subject to amendment from time to time as the Committee sees fit. The disc will apply to one car per Full Member and will be valid for a period of one Membership Year (1 April to 31 March). The cost of the parking disc will not be pro-rated as the year progresses, and will only be re-issued to a Member if they sell and replace their vehicle during the Membership Year. A Full Club Member has no authority to permit any other person to use their parking privilege, and must only list vehicles of which they are personally the registered keeper with the Guernsey Aero Club. Failure to display a purchased disc will result in the GAC Committee issuing a parking fine which is set at this time at £50, but can be varied from time to time as the Committee see fit. This fine will not constitute payment for a parking disc, which will need to be purchased in addition should the Member wish to continue parking overnight/long stay.
 - 4) If you are a Full Club Member and you are parking for more than twelve hours whether remaining on or travelling off island, and when there is a special event at the Club, such as the Open Day or on Air Rally weekends you must ensure that your car is parked on the

gravel surfaced overflow car park at the rear of the Aero Club Hangar (shown edged in red on the attached sketch plan).

- 5) Please ensure that as far as possible your car is parked at the westernmost end of the overflow car park, i.e. furthest away from the Clubhouse, and always within the parking space line markings keeping clear of the hangar rear access steps.
- 6) If a Member wishes to leave a vehicle parked for longer than fourteen days, they must notify the Club Administrator in advance and may be required to leave a set of car keys with the Club Administrator in case the vehicle has to be moved in your absence.
- 7) When there is a special event at the Club such as the Open Day or on Air Rally weekend the Executive Committee reserves the right to ask you to move your vehicle for the weekend and an alternative parking area will be suggested.
